USER MENU

followed by the User Code. The first User Menu item is... Unset Press to Unset the system Press to scroll to... **Full Arm** Press to Arm the system with an Exit Timer Press to scroll to... **Quick Arm** Press to quickly Arm the system (i.e. No Exit Timer) Press to scroll to... Part Arm A? Press to only Arm the zones assigned to svstem A Press to scroll to... Part Arm B? to only Arm the zones assigned to Press svstem B Press to scroll to... View User Log? Press to view the most recent events logged on your system. Press to scroll to... to activate Walk Test - then when you Walk Test? Press activate a zone its number/description will appear on the display Press to scroll to... Chime On/Off? Press to activate or deactivate a zone with the Chime feature - ask your installer for details Press to scroll to... **Bell Test?** Press and then follow the on-screen prompts to activate your sirens/bells Press to scroll to... Manager Menu? Press to enter a special menu with added features - ask your installer for details

MANAGER MENU Manager Menu ? Press to enter the Manager Menu (if permitted) Press to scroll to... Set Date&Time? Press REC to change the system's date & time Press to scroll to... View Eng. Log? Press to view up to 999 events logged in the system memory e.g. Alarm activations Press to scroll to... **User Codes?** Press to add a new User Code or change an existing one - follow the on-screen prompts Press to scroll to... **User Options?** Press REC to change a User Code's features e.g. whether it can unset a system, inhibit a zone etc. - follow the on-screen prompts Press to scroll to... User Names ? Press to change a User Code's name to something more meaningful e.g. from U01User1 to U01Peter Press (to scroll to... User Blk Assign? Press to assign User Codes to the Blocks (if any) in your system. Note: B0 = common area, B1 - Block 1 etc. Press to scroll to... **User ProxAssign?** Press U01 Tag Unused will be on the display. Note: you can scroll to U02, U03 etc. For additional users. Next, bring the proximity fob/tag to the keypad to be activated This is the location on the keypad to read a proximity tag. Press to scroll to... System Config ? twice. The engineer can now enter Press engineer mode with just his code (no need for a user code). When he does,

the internal siren will activate.



SYSTEM UNSET

To unset the system or cancel an alarm Press followed by User Code




Note: If there was an alarm activation then the keypad will make an announcement.

Part set will automatically inhibit the following zones




Keypad displays.... System Arming

NOTES: Zones inhibited in Part Set will remain inactive for the duration of system set.


System Arming

ZONE INHIBIT (STOP)



Zones inhibited will remain inactive for the duration of the system set. This feature should be used with caution having first identified the reason for the zone condition





Keypad displays...



System will now set with Zone 5 inhibited

It is possible to inhibit a number of zones as shown below.

Example 2: To inhibit zones 5 & 3




NOTE: System will set in normal manner

FORCED ARMING CAUTION



Zones inhibited by forced arming will remain inactive for the duration of the system set. This feature should be used with caution having first identified the reason for the zone condition.

Example: Zones 3, 4, 5 & 7 are open



System will now set with Zones 3,4,5 and 7 automatically inhibited for the duration of the system set.


REMOTE RESET

Your system may be programmed to trigger a remote reset after a confirmed alarm activation. In which case follow the instructions below...

Press of followed by the User Code. The first User Menu item is...



After the system announces the alarm events the following appears on the display...



When you contact the Call Centre give them the five-digit number. They, in return, will give you a <u>different</u> five-digit number. Use this to reset the system.

Note: you will need to reset the system otherwise you will not be able to arm it

When you try to arm the system you will see the following...

Reset Code:----

Simply key-in the five-digit number given to you by the call centre. You will then see...




You are now free to continue arming your system

RF-KEYFOB

If your system has an RF-Keyfob please note the following.

RF-Keyfob in Quick Key mode

Green:- Transmission OK, Red: Transmission not OK, Orange:- Out of range



*This time is programmable - ask your installers for details

Normally the RF-Keyfob works in "Quick Key" mode.

However, you may ask your installer to set it up for "Secure Unset" mode.

In "Secure Unset" mode, to unset the system or to cancel an alarm press ① followed by User Code.

Also in "Secure Unset" mode;

Press for Full Set

Press for Part-set A

Press for Part-set B

Press (9) to toggles Lights On/Off (if applicable)

Note: Always make sure you get a green "transmission OK" light otherwise you will have to repeat your keypress.
